



**Stony Point High School
International Baccalaureate
Declaration Statement**



The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme (DP) is an advanced academic option for high school juniors and seniors at Stony Point High School. For those students zoned to attend either Round Rock High School or Cedar Ridge High School, a Round Rock ISD In-District Transfer Form is required to participate in IB at SPHS. Students will be required to declare their interest in the IB Diploma Programme beginning in the spring semester of their 8th grade year. All prospective IB students are required to sign and submit this form to the IB Coordinator's office.

Participation in the IB Programme requires students to take certain preparatory courses (SPHS IB Prep) during their freshmen and sophomore years. Students in the SPHS IB Prep Programme will automatically be registered for these classes and highly encouraged to take other recommended course work. These courses have been selected to maximize student preparation for IB DP courses during the 11th and 12th grades.

Embedded Course Credits and Course Requests: IB DP students earn Government and Economics credit through their IB History of the Americas Courses. Speech credit is also earned through the IB Theory of Knowledge class. **Please note that as an IB student, IB courses take priority over all other special programs. While every effort will be made to accommodate non-IB course and program requests, we cannot guarantee that non-IB classes will fit into the IB schedule.**

Transferring to SPHS for IB: Transfer students participating in the IB Diploma Programme must annually resubmit their RRISD In-District Transfer Form. Transfers can be rescinded by the campus principal for academic malfeasance, a failure to earn course credit, and disciplinary infractions – including excessive absences. **Students have the right to return to their home campus at the end of any academic year.** Your signature and submission of this document constitutes acknowledgement of the Stony Point IB Diploma Programme requirements and Round Rock ISD transfer policies.
