



Stony Point High School May 2022 IB Exam Registration



Dear Parents and Guardians of IB Students:

Taking the International Baccalaureate exams is vital to your student's success in the Diploma Programme. Stony Point High School requires that all students take IB exams for the IB classes in which they are enrolled. Scoring well on these exams earns students college credit for their high school classes which saves a significant amount on tuition.

For the MAY 2022 IB exams, students at Stony Point High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with Internet access.

This year, each IB exam **costs \$121.00**. In order for us to maintain accurate records, students who registered for IB exams last year through Total Registration were sent an email reminding them to use the email address they entered in the system previously.

Stony Point High School desires that every student be able to take their IB exams. **Students requiring financial assistance must complete and submit the Financial Assistance Application Form to Ms. Brosché, IB Coordinator via email on or before October 22, 2021. Applicants will be notified by email before October 27, 2021 regarding their status.**

Any Stony Point IB student who is testing may apply for financial assistance/ payment plan for IB registration and exam fees. The amount of funding available from year to year varies, so there is no guarantee of financial assistance for students who are not served by the Free or Reduced Lunch program. On-time online registration will be open from Wednesday, October 6, 2021 to Friday, October 29, 2021 at 11:59 pm.

Registrations entered into the system after the on-time deadline will incur additional fees. In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit:

To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the PDF of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams; however, we strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered. Students must submit their **Exam Policy Signature Page electronically to Ms. Brosché on or before October 29, 2021**. This form contains important information about our refund policy, illness policy, attendance policy, academic standing, Extended Essay and CAS requirements, and changes to examination registration. Parents and students must acknowledge that they have read and understand all the examination policies before students are allowed to sit for exams.
